Because of the great volume of entries submitted to the exhibition in the past, an attempt was made in the last two years to divide the exhibition according to artistic media, Painting and Sculpture, and Prints and Drawings. It was felt that this division was not a success and it was, therefore, decided to return to the old method of incorporating works in all media in the exhibition. A new experiment, however, is attempted this year by inviting additional works of certain prizewinners to be included in the exhibition, thereby giving artists who are awarded the top prizes a broader exposure than they would receive were only one of their works shown. It is hoped that this will prove interesting to the public and meaningful to the artists.

The significant role that the artist plays in our society is reflected in the artistic climate in his community. The Art Institute of Chicago through this exhibition and through our "Art Rental and Sales Gallery" hopes that by these activities we are helping to bring the artist and the public closer together.

We wish to express our gratitude to our Jury, George Segal, noted artist; Samuel J. Wagstaff, Curator of Contemporary Art, The Detroit Institute of Arts; and our Curator of Twentieth Century Art, A. James Speyer, for the fine work they have done in selecting the exhibition. We congratulate the prizewinners and the exhibitors also, and to those whose work was not accepted for the present show, we wish success another year.
